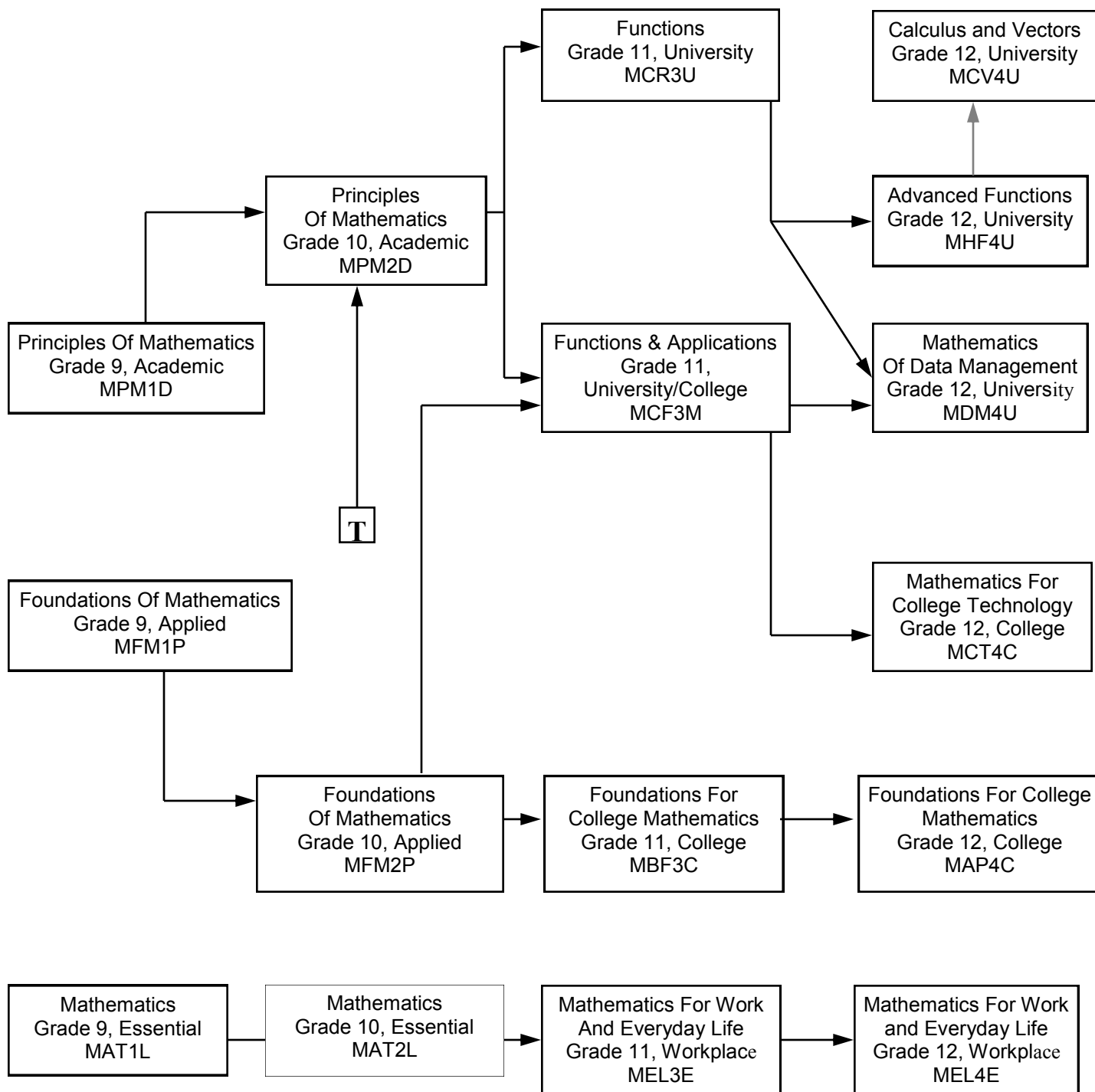
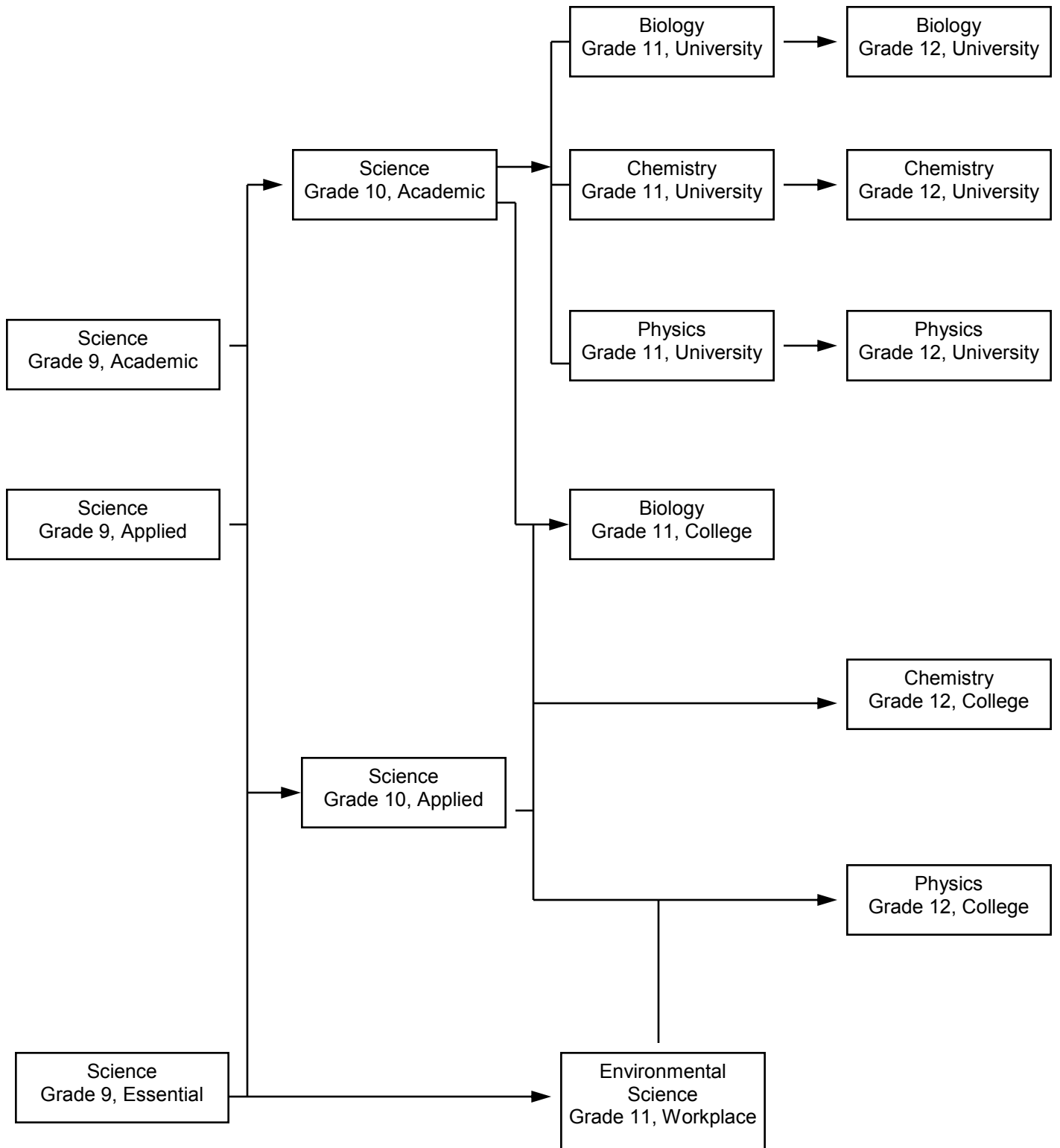


Prerequisite Chart for Mathematics

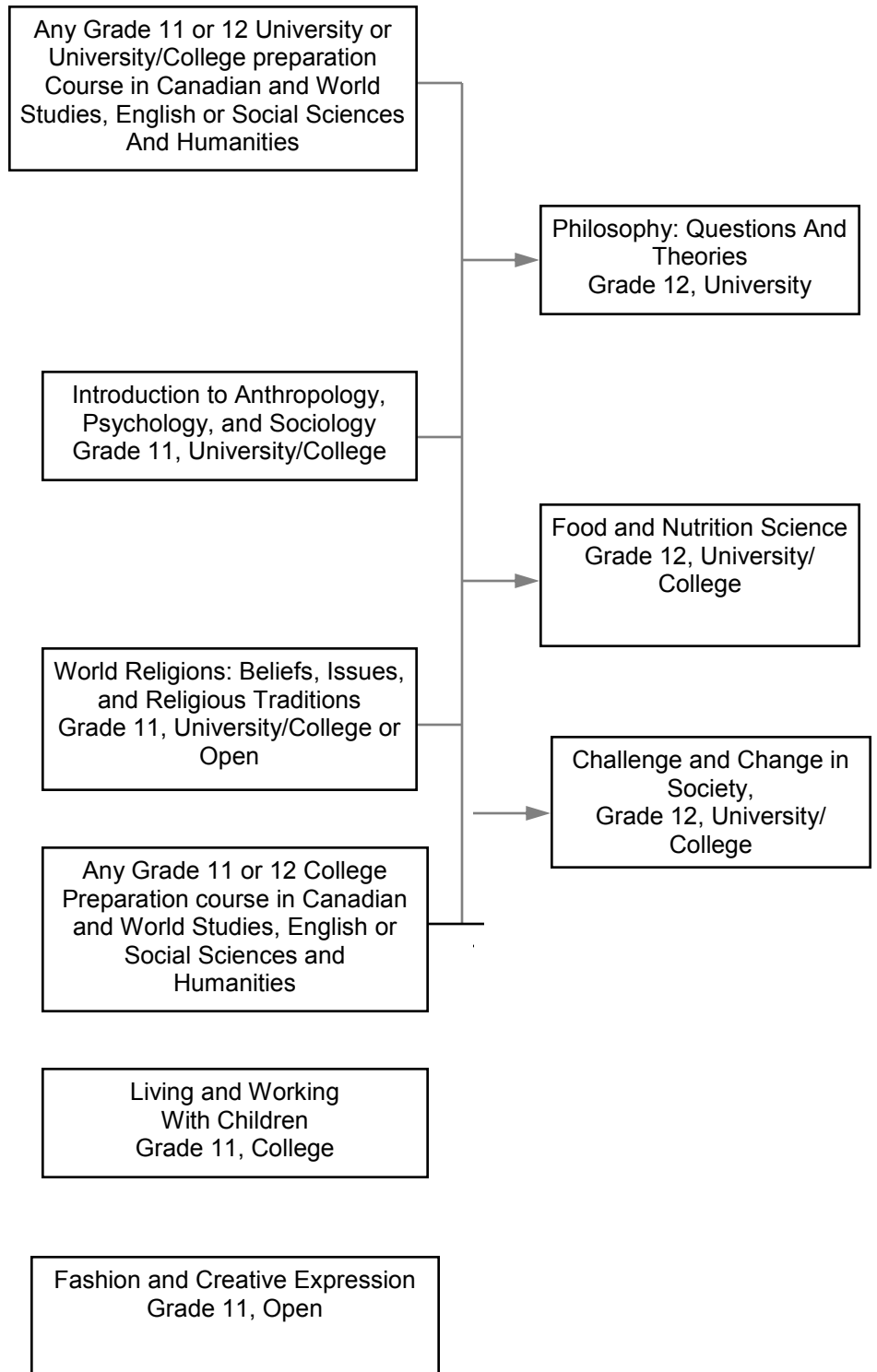

Prerequisite Chart for Science

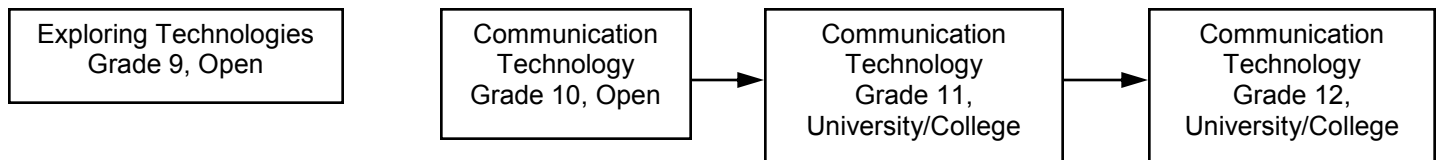


Prerequisite Chart for Social Sciences and the Humanities

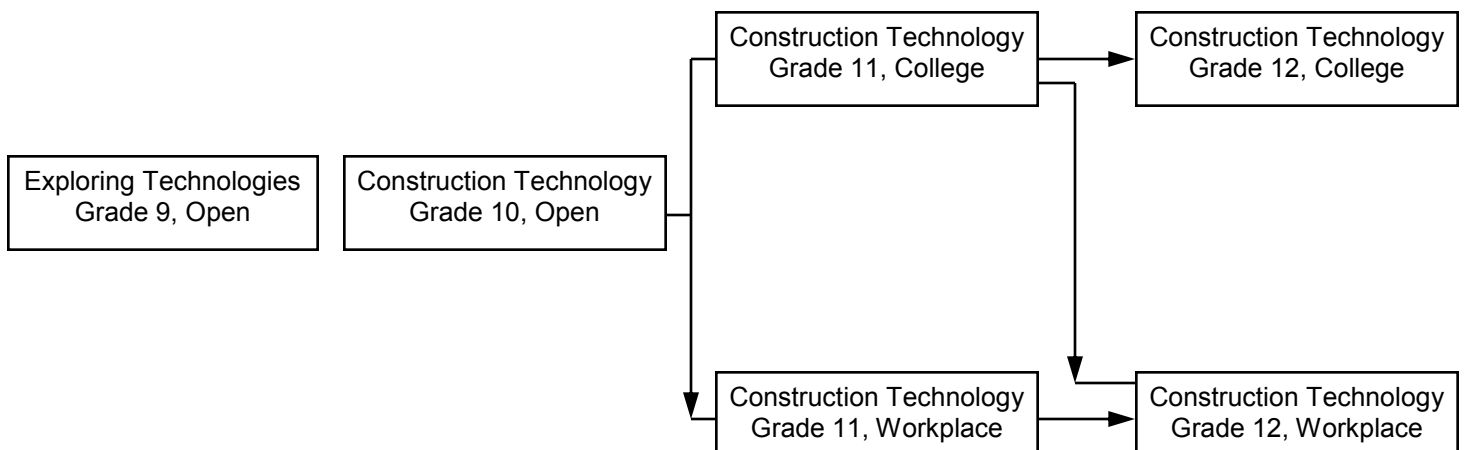


Prerequisite Chart for Technological Education

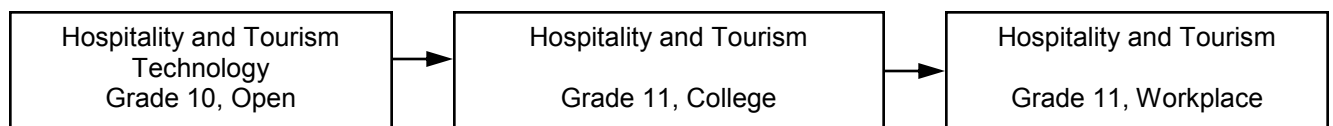

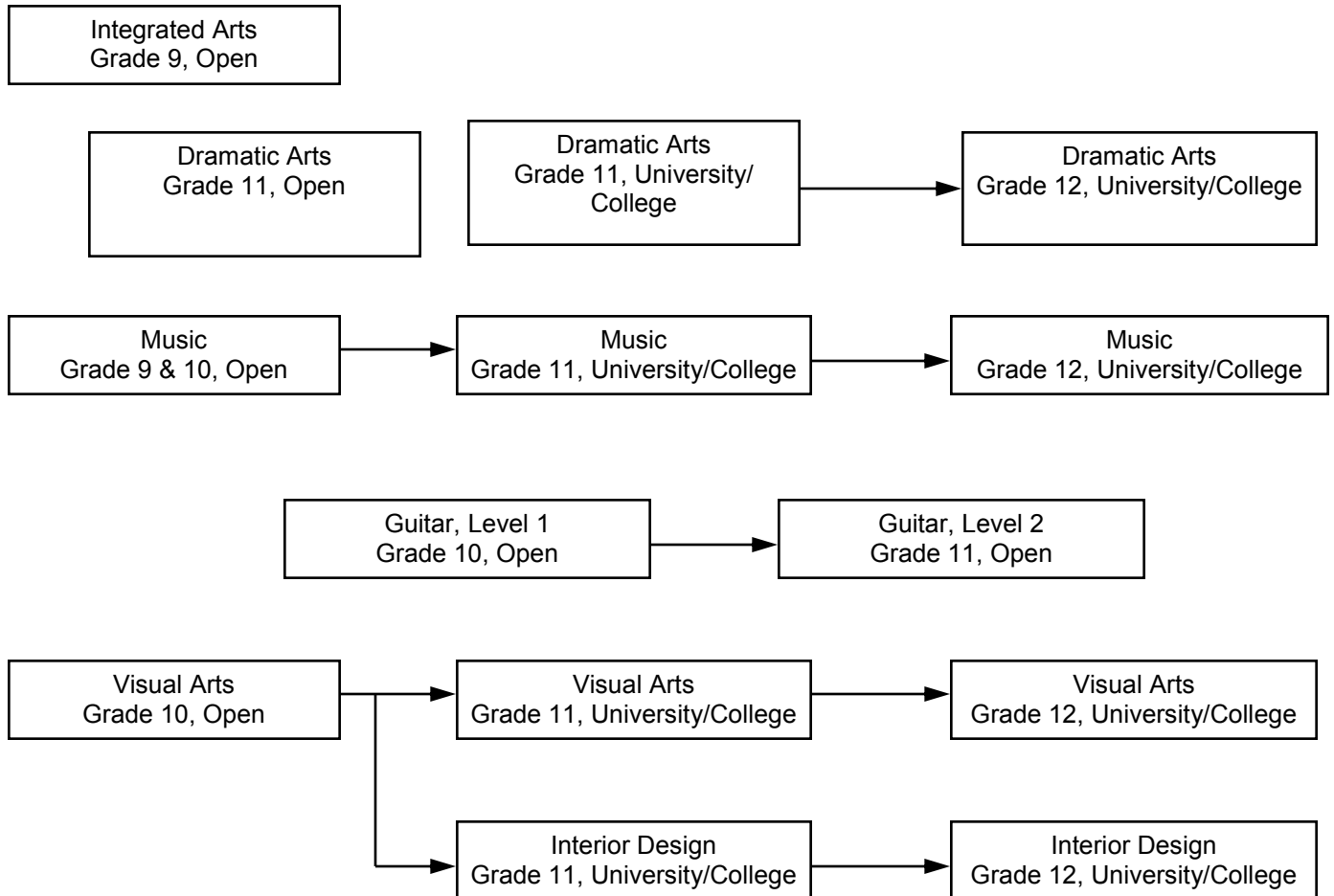

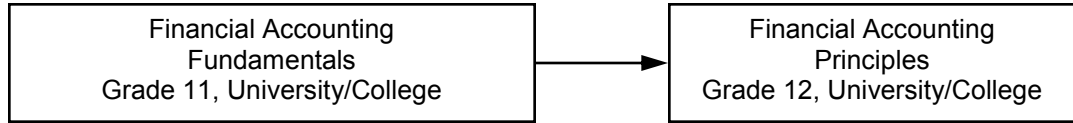
Section D: Program Planning Charts
